How much financial support you need:

travel money / housing costs

meetings do NOT need to be BIG

important: “mixed meetings”

for example 3 “finite group” people meet with 4 “algebraic group” people and 3 “Lie group” people

## **How to get money for a visitor**

Send an informal letter (not only email)

How much financial support you need:

lump sum: travel money + living costs approx. 2.000 - 2500 per month

- a quick alternative for younger people to keep the cooperation running with groups outside Germany: Scientific Networks: Research Grant to promote scientific exchange; Qualified are early career researchers (as a rule, those holding a doctorate) working at German research institutions.
